OUR HISTORY

In 1937, Bing Crosby invited a group of friends to get together for some golf, a clambake and, most importantly, to raise money for local charities. Since that time, the tournament, now known as the AT&T Pebble Beach National Pro-Am, has become one of the most popular and internationally recognized stops on the PGA TOUR and the spirit of giving back has continued through the Monterey Peninsula Foundation.

BACKGROUND

The Foundation is governed by a board of directors which sets policy, approves grants, and develops ongoing and strategic plans for the growth and stability of the Foundation. Day-to-day operations are directed by a professional staff of 13 employees. Since the AT&T Pebble Beach National Pro-Am came to the Monterey Peninsula in 1947, nearly \$66 million has been raised for nonprofit organizations in Monterey County and surrounding communities.

The Monterey Peninsula Foundation is exclusively philanthropic and is responsible for the disbursement of the funds raised for charitable organizations which enhance the quality of life of the residents of Monterey County and surrounding areas.

The Monterey Peninsula Foundation provides grants to nonprofit organizations that benefit the community in the areas of Arts & Culture, Community & Environment, Education, Health & Human Services, and Youth, primarily in Monterey and Santa Cruz counties in Central California. The Foundation also operates the Youth Fund for youth-oriented programs and schools.

The First Tee of Monterey County is a nonprofit chapter of The First Tee, established nationally in November 1997. It currently manages and operates the 9 hole par 31 Twin Creeks Golf Course in Salinas with nearly 1,000 youth in programs throughout Monterey County.
